USA	Is Dash illegal in Canada (Click me for details)?	The purpose of Dash is to make very low fee, instant, private payments online or in-store using the secure open-source platform hosted by thousands of users around the world.	N/A	Dash's long-term success will likely be due to its lower transaction fees. However, like Bitcoin, Dash will face scaling issues and it doesn't have the benefit of Bitcoin's first mover advantage.
USA	Is Stellar illegal in Canada (Click me for details)?	Stellar is making it more efficient, low-cost and secure to make interbank global transfers in less than 5 seconds. The Stellar Development Foundation is also working to increase financial services access to unbanked parts of the world.	N/A	I think Stellar's long-term strategy is favorable as it has many use cases and has already begun eating away at Ripple's first mover advantage as the go-to crypto for banks.
Japan	Is Cardano illegal in Canada (Click me for details)?	Cardano is a cryptocurrency platform that runs the very secure blockchain for its cryptocurrency, ADA. The only wallet that accepts ADA is called Daedalus.	N/A	If Cardano can successfully integrate the functionalities of other coins and platforms into one entity as it proposes, then it will be able to realize its potential of becoming the largest cryptocurrency.
China	Is NEO illegal in Canada (Click me for details)?	NEO is known as China's form of Ethereum. It is an ecosystem for smart contracts and allows users to store and exchange digital assets.	N/A	Because NEO is the largest cryptocurrency in China and is not just a coin but an ecosystem, the long-term strategy is very promising and exponentially more promising if they continue to work hand in hand with the Chinese government.
USA	Is Zcash illegal in Canada (Click me for details)?	Zcash is the first open, permissionless cryptocurrency that can fully protect the privacy of transactions using zero-knowledge cryptography.	N/A	In the long run, governments will increase regulations on cryptocurrencies and when that happens, Zcash will increase in importance as it is able to fully protect the privacy of cryptocurrency transactions through zero-knowledge cryptography. This technology will allow crypto traders to secure their funds in an inevitably regulated crypto market of the near future.
N/A	Is Monero illegal in Canada (Click me for details)?	Monero was created to be a much more secure cryptocurrency. It uses a sophisticated signature with every transaction, making it impossible for an outsider to trace.	N/A	Since Monero's value proposition is having a fully private and untraceable blockchain, the cryptocurrency should prosper in the long run as long as it can solve its scalability issues (please see Step 21 below for more details).
Singapore	Is Litecoin illegal in Canada (Click me for details)?	Litecoin is digital currency that allows individuals to transfer funds directly between themselves or businesses without an intermediary bank or payment processing service. Litecoin is often referred to as Bitcoin's little brother and digital silver. It's purpose is for it to be used as a daily currency since it has faster transaction speeds than Bitcoin does.	N/A	If Litecoin is used less as an investment vehicle and more of a practical usable currency, it will, in the long run increase in value and become a reputable currency (many think of Litecoin as being used for smaller transactions and Bitcoin for larger transactions).
USA	Is Ripple illegal in Canada (Click me for details)?	Ripple offers a global real time cost efficient payment system for transactions between financial companies.	N/A	Ripple has secured partnerships with numerous financial institutions as part of its long-term strategy to improve domestic and international banking processes. I think Ripple is on a great track for long-term success given the fact that there is already widespread adoption from large financial services companies.
Switzerland	Is Ethereum illegal in Canada (Click me for details)?	Ethereum doesn't just offer a cryptocurrency, it's so much more as it is a decentralized platform that runs smart contracts: applications that run exactly as programmed without any possibility of downtime, censorship, fraud or third-party interference.	N/A	Ethereum's long-term strategy is very favorable since its technology is not only disruptive, but also based on its own platform with incredible growth potential (the best investments in technology often have their own platform, like Facebook, Apple, Amazon with Amazon Web Services, etc). Unlike Bitcoin which is a stand alone coin, Ethereum's platform value proposition and its movement towards smart contracts and transaction efficiency means that Ethereum has no equal competitor. A majority of ICOs are reliant on Ethereum's technology to run their applications. Also, Ethereum has the largest developer community.
N/A	Is Bitcoin illegal in Canada (Click me for details)?	Bitcoin is a digital currency that can be traded on the blockchain, the decentralized digital ledger. Bitcoin was built to transact and send money between two or more parties anonymously.	N/A	I think that because Bitcoin has been around the longest and has gone through numerous ebbs and flows it has lots of promise for long-term viability as a potential substitute for gold (meaning this is digital gold). Bitcoin also has the benefit of being the notable first crypto to gain wide acceptance (first mover advantage).
